Title: COUPLE INDICTED IN DEATH OF CHILD.(News)

Courts -- A Forest Park couple was indicted Monday in connection with the death of a 16-month-old girl for whom they were caring.

A Hamilton County grand jury indicted Jonathan W. and Tokola Glover, both 27, for involuntary manslaughter and child endangering, charges carrying a maximum prison sentence of 15 years.

The charges against the Glovers stem from the Dec. 13 death of Jamira Marie Chenault.

Tokola Glover is the child's cousin and guardian and had been watching her for the month prior to her death at the request of the child's mother.

The Glovers brought the child Dec. 9 to Children's Hospital because she had a high fever and was "sleepy," the couple told authorities.

The child was rushed to surgery but died Dec. 13. The Hamilton County coroner later ruled the death a homicide and that the child died from blunt trauma to the head.

Initially, the Glovers reported the child fell from a bed but officials said that story was inconsistent with the injuries.
